Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SHUTCM)

This is a 5-year program, 3 trimesters per academic year.

Graduation and Academic Degree

A Bachelor of Chinese Medicine will be awarded upon completion of

- Required credits of all courses
- General points average (GPA)
- Pass of all examinations

Type of class

Independent class with minimum 5 students

Application Time

December 1, 2025 – June 30, 2026

Program Intake

September, 2026 (Please see the date on Admission Notice)

Eligibility

- Nationality Eligibility: Foreign passport holder without Chinese citizenship and comply with the relevant regulations outlined in *“Document No. 12 (2020) of Ministry of Education of the PRC”*
- High school graduation or higher education background
- Pass China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA). See www.cscacn.cn for more details.

**The required CSCA subjects are defined by the program applied for:

- Applicants for Medical Degrees taught in English must take Mathematics. The exam is conducted in English.
- English Proficiency:
 - (a) Completed courses taught in English and transcripts required
 - OR
 - (b) >90 of TOEFL or >6 of IELTS (non-native English speakers)
- Under 60 years of age; exceptions can be considered for applicants with competitive academic background or those recommended by collaborative universities.

Fees

- CNY 450 for application (The actual amount the university receives, non-refundable)
- CNY 42,000/year for tuition
- CNY 800/year for students' insurance
- Purchase fee for textbooks
- Accommodation Fee
 - Live on campus: Please see Introduction of International Student's Dormitory (Attachment 2). Notice of the accommodation arrangement will be sent out in middle July. (The accommodation fee may fluctuate).
 - Live off-campus: Students can live off-campus upon approval by the University and pay on themselves.

Application Documents

- Scan of the passport (Passport info cannot be changed after the submission until the completion of enrollment, thus minimum 10 month’s validity is advised)
- Applicants with either one or both parents being Chinese citizens must submit the following documents as specified:
 - Proof of having acquired a foreign nationality by birth; or proof of having acquired a foreign nationality through immigration.
 - For applicants who have acquired a foreign nationality by birth,
 - a) If the Chinese citizen parent(s) holds foreign permanent residency, proof of the parent(s) permanent residency status must be provided.
 - b) If the Chinese citizen parent(s) lacks foreign permanent residency, proof of the applicant’s renunciation of Chinese nationality must be provided.
 - For applicants who have acquired a foreign nationality through immigration, proof of the applicant’s cancellation of the previous Chinese household registration (Hukou) and renunciation of Chinese nationality must be provided.
 - Applicants must complete the “Statement of Nationality and Entry/Exit Information”(See Attachment 7) based on the entry and exit stamps in the passport for all travels between China and other countries from April 30 (included) 2022 to the application date.
- Proof of the application fee payment (Applicant’s application ID and full name must be included)
- Test result of China Scholastic Competency Assessment(The latest date to submit it is June 30 2026)
- Certificate of Non-Criminal Record (See Attachment 5)
- Statement of Financial Support (See Attachment 6)
- Copy of TOEFL or IELTS examination results (no requirement for native speakers).
- Student ID Photo:
 - Rename: Passport Name (English)
 - Background Color: Blue or White
 - Pixel: ≥300 pixels/inch
 - Other Requirement: Bareheaded

NOTE: The photo will be used for your student ID card. Please make sure the photo is exactly as above requirements.

The aforementioned documents must be submitted online at <https://apply.shutcm.edu.cn> before the deadline. The application will not be processed if the documents are incomplete or sent by email. Applicants may need to submit supplementary documents when the Admissions Office requires. Qualified applicants will receive admission letters sent by email from SHUTCM starting from May.

Scholarships

- Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship

Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship for international students shall be delivered according to relevant documents including Regulations on Application of Shanghai Municipal Government Scholarship for International Students. Applicants must complete the online application at the school portal. Application fee only needs to be paid for once. For more information, please see: <https://iec.shutcm.edu.cn/en/598/list.htm>

Please confirm with the school before submitting application if clarification is needed regards entry requirements for applicants with health issues.
